Message From Our Manager

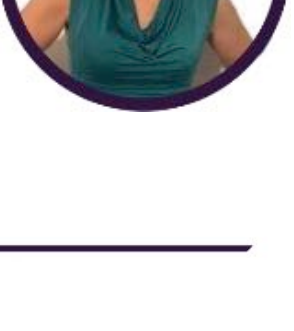

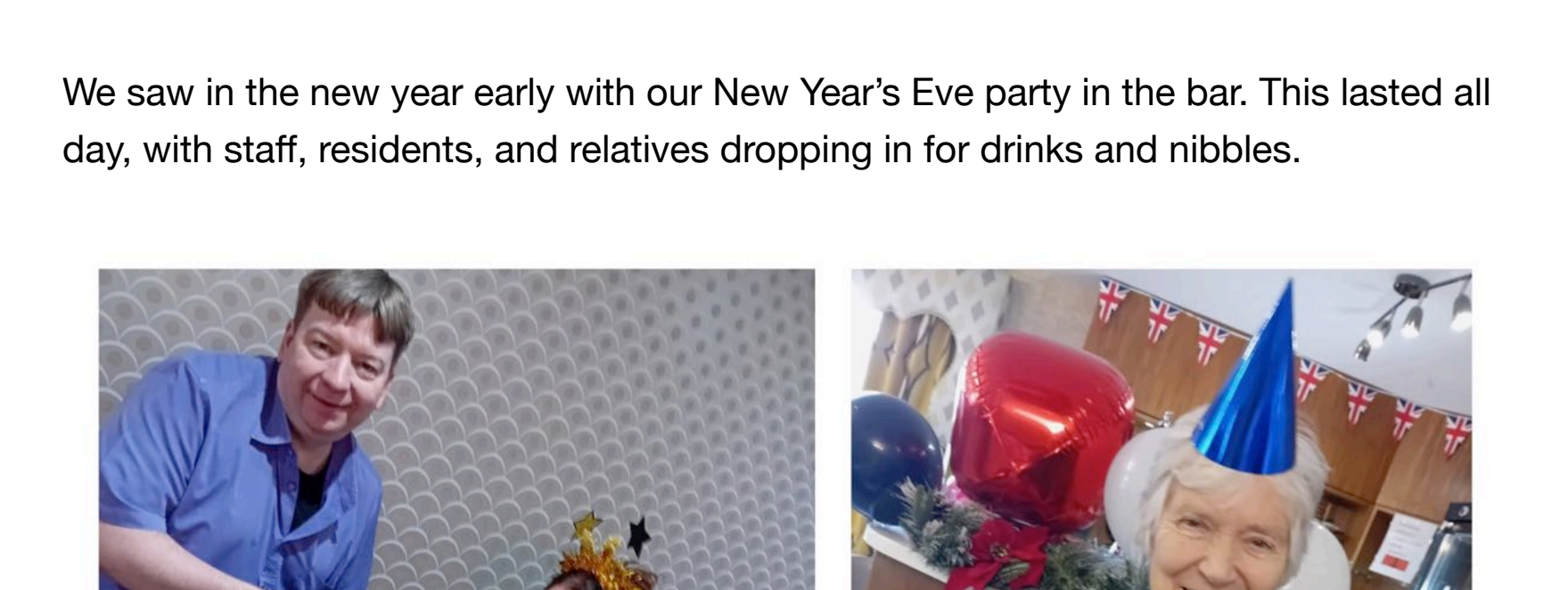
Lots of Snow

We saw in the new year early with our New Year's Eve party in the bar. This lasted all day, with staff, residents, and relatives dropping in for drinks and nibbles.

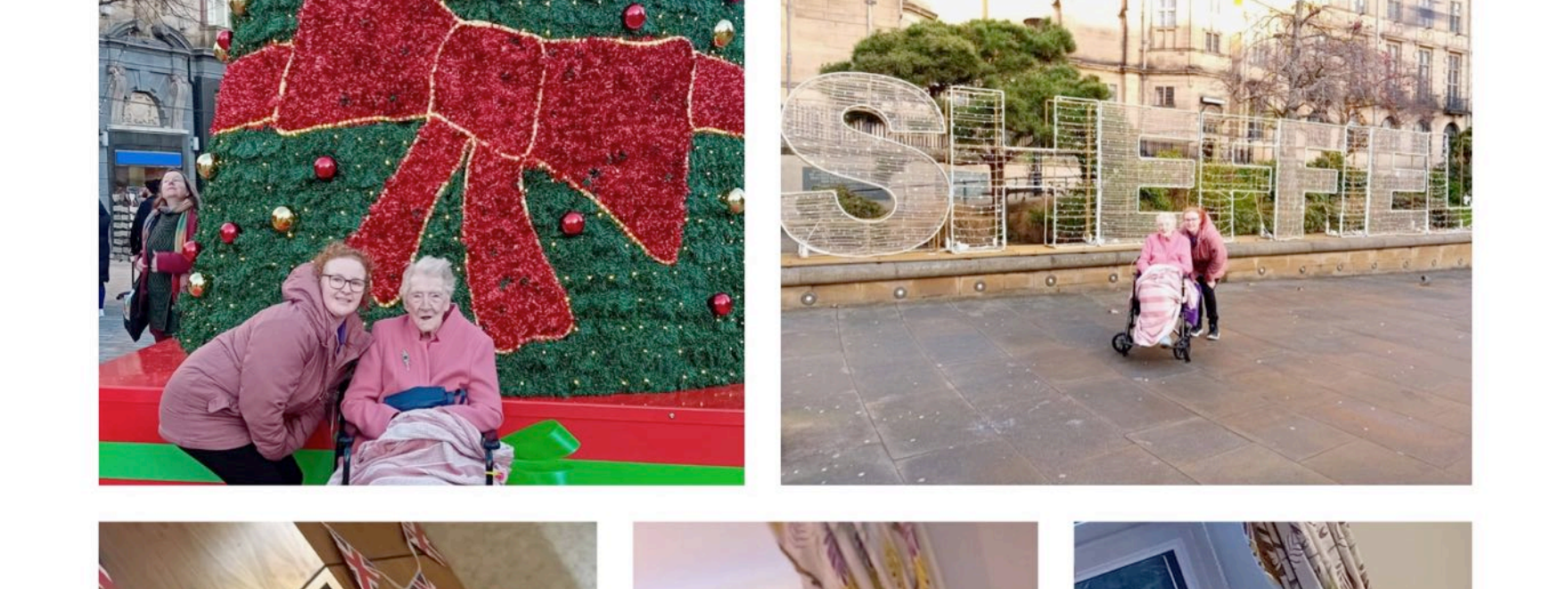
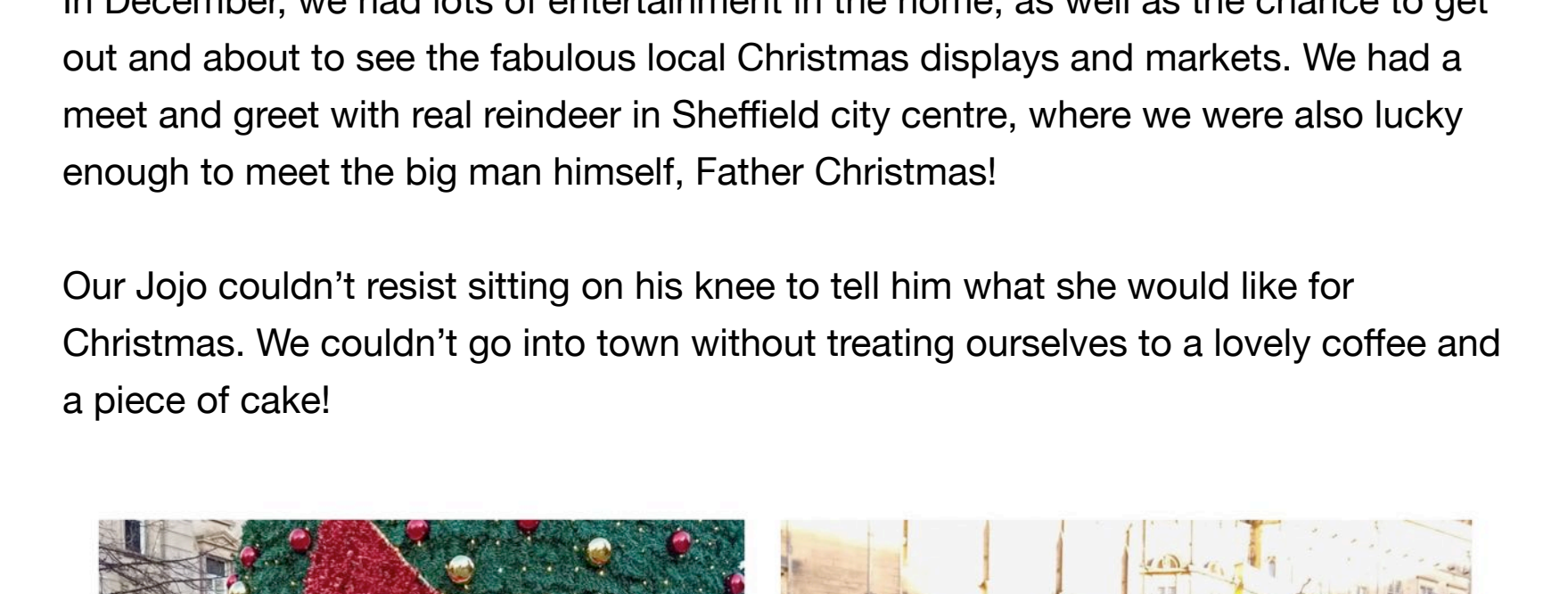


FESTIVE FUN

A Wonderful Christmas Time

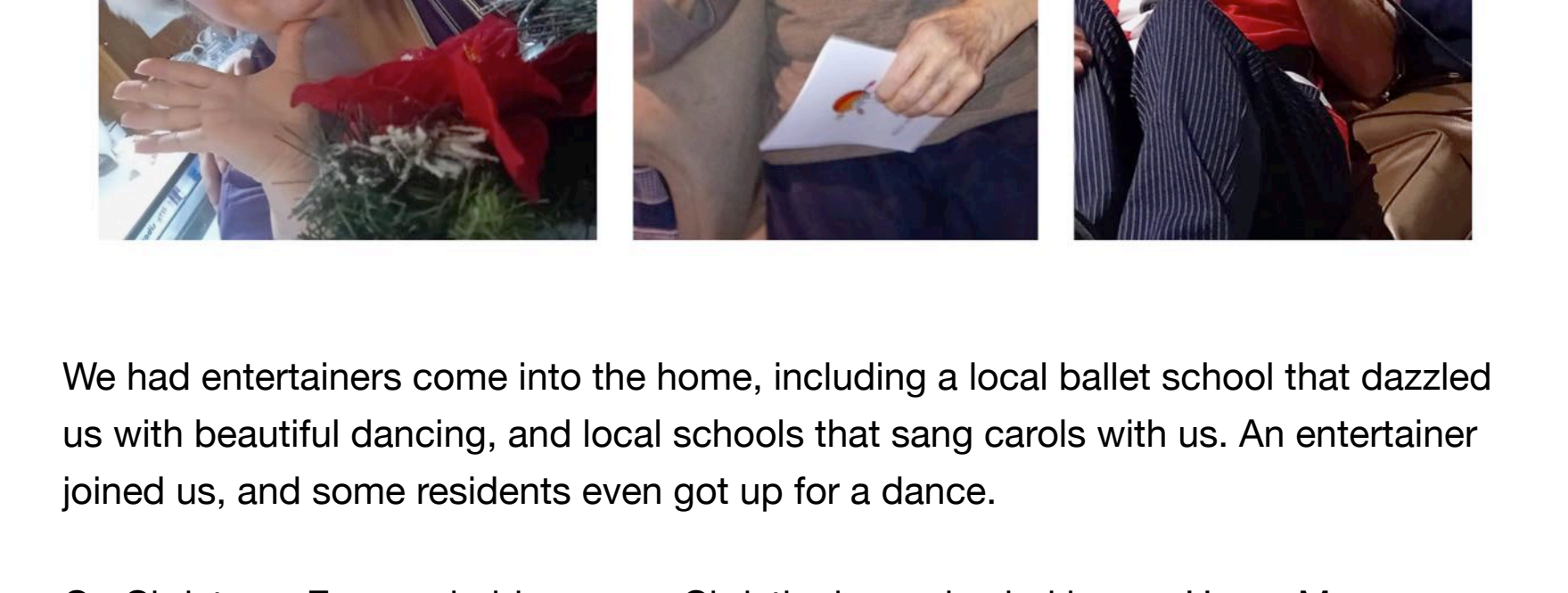

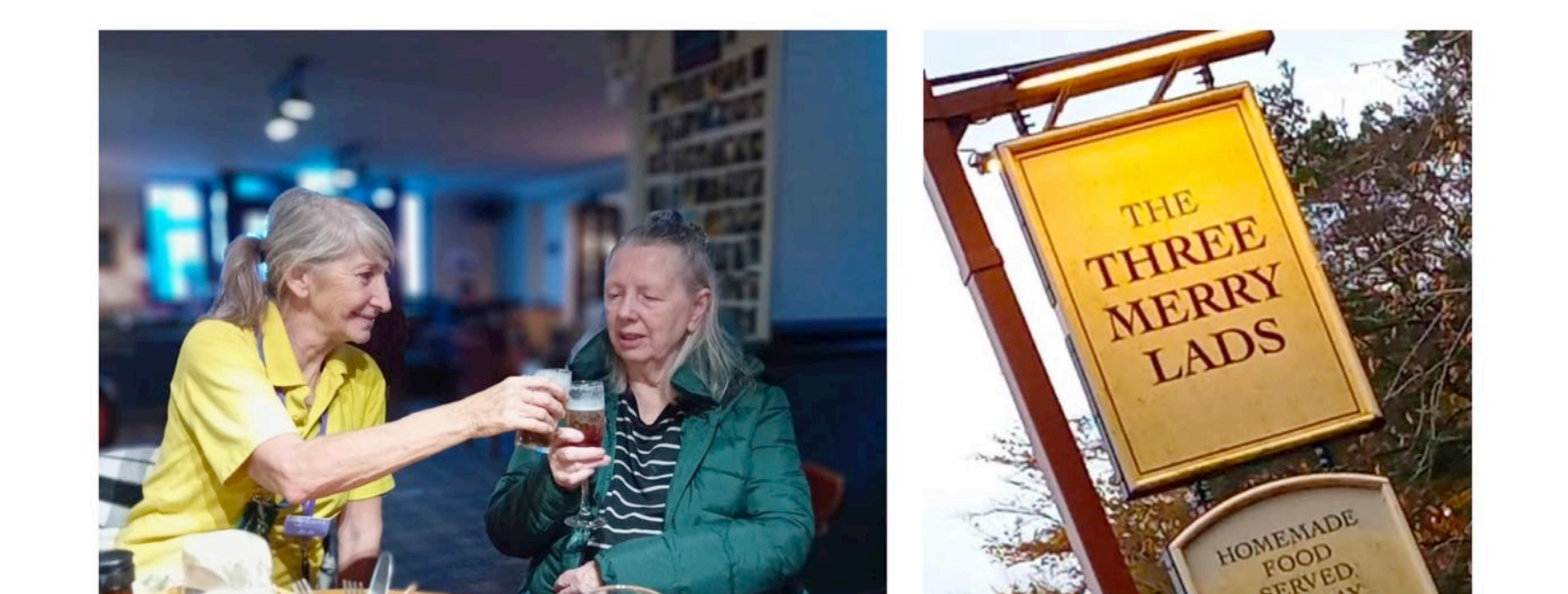

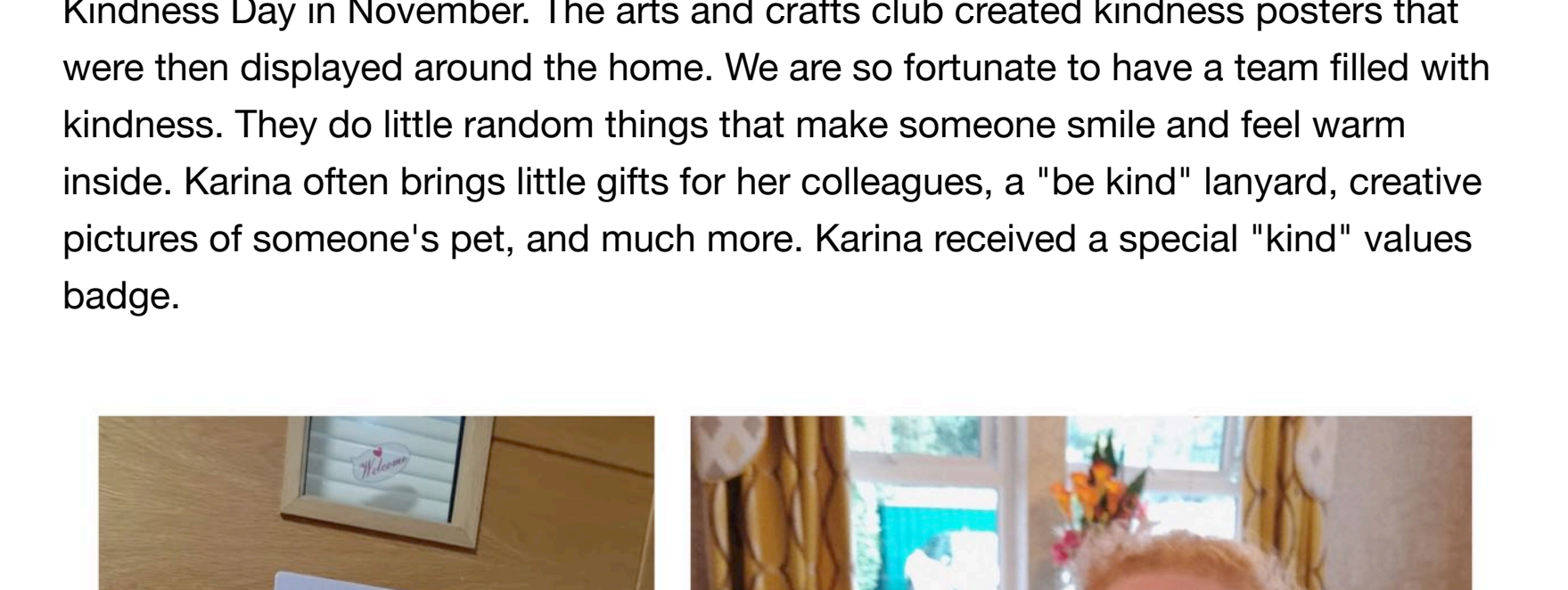
Out & About

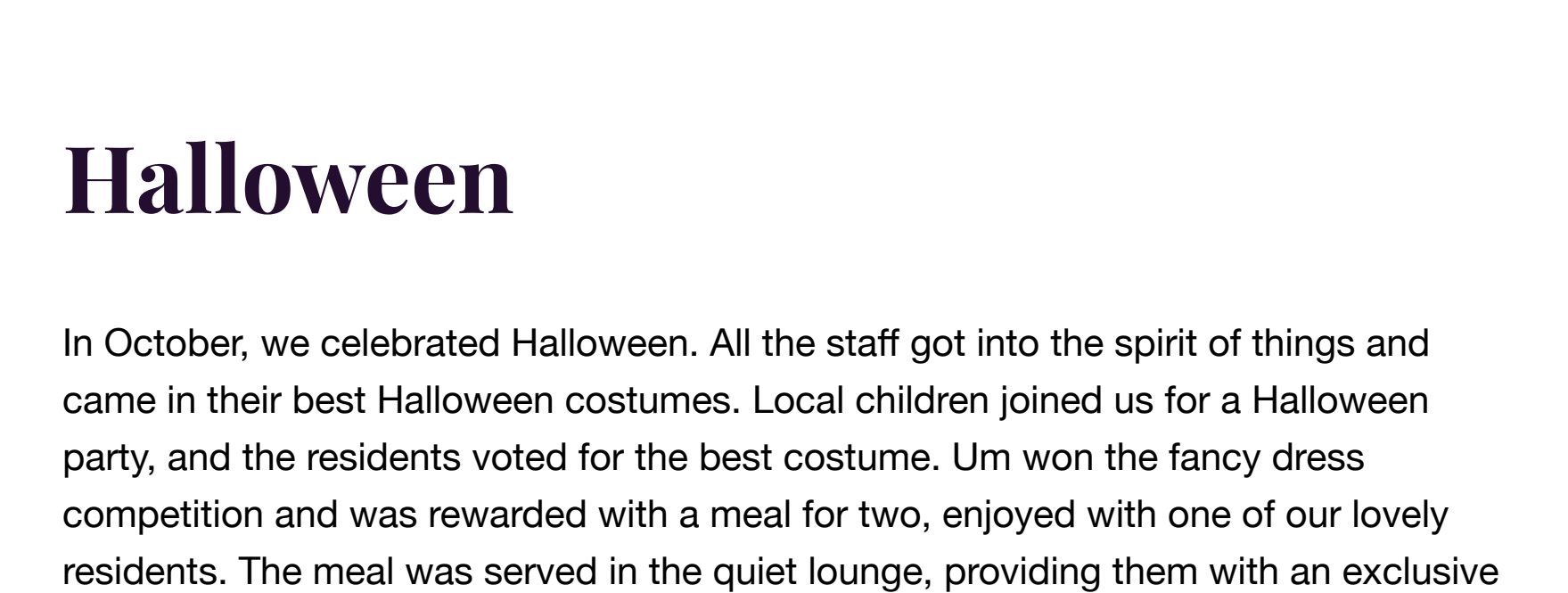
World Kindness Day

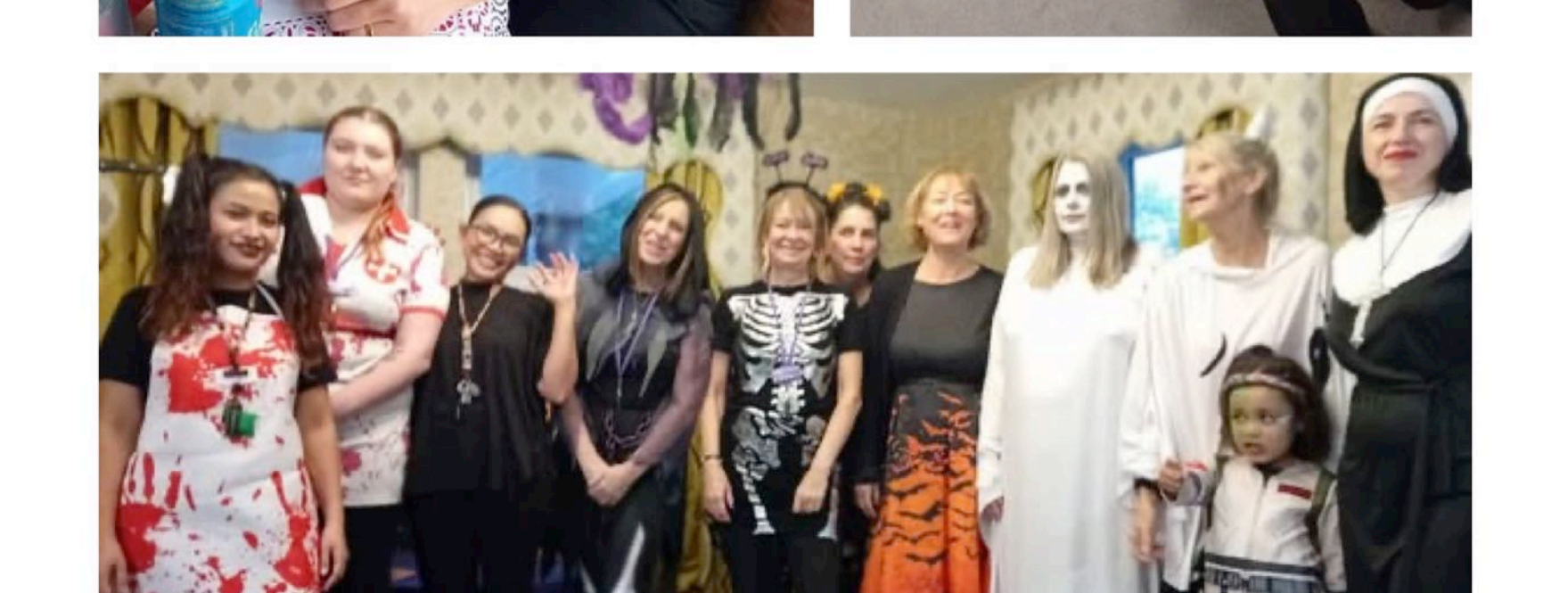


Halloween

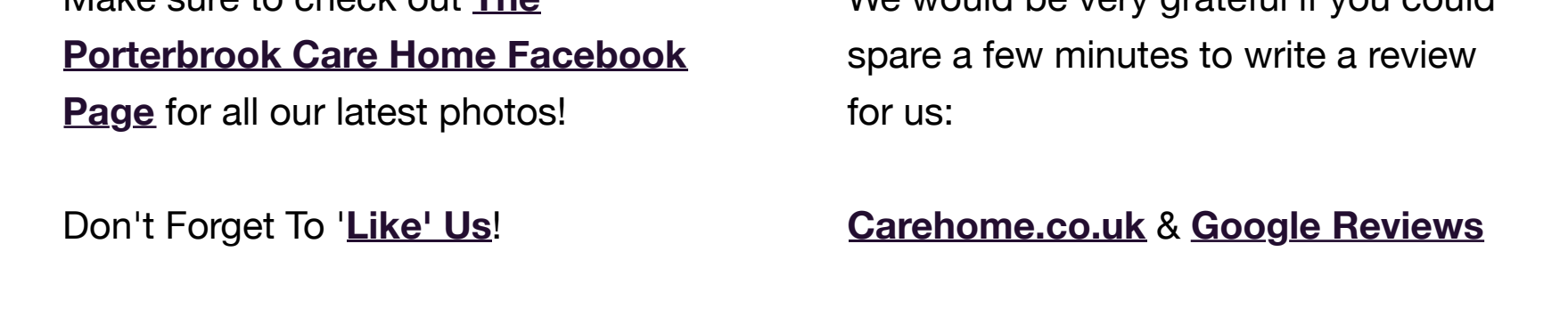
